ABOUT PINEY CAMPGROUND...

Piney Campground offers 384 well-defined sites with 281 electrical hookups, 44 sites with electric, water, and sewer, and 59 primitive sites. Most sites are capable of handling large motor homes and campers. Campers have access to modern facilities, including a beach and swimming area, archery range, ball field, bike trails, a campfire theater, hiking trails, two boat ramps, and a fishing pier. Piney has 9 primitive cabins available for nightly rental in the campground. In addition, the summer season will offer daily recreation programs for all ages. Piney Outpost offers camping supplies and rental services.

CAMPSITE GUIDELINES...

During your stay with us, please help provide a quality experience for all our visitors.

1. Campsites are available on a first-come, first-served basis or by reservation. For reservations, please refer to the "Reservations" section. **For first-come, first-served sites, at least one person 18 years of age or older and a proper camping unit must immediately occupy the site for the first night. (36 CFR 261.6 (h)) After the first night, the camping unit may not be left unattended for more than a 24-hour period without permission.**
2. **First-come, first-served campsites will be assigned upon registering at the gatehouse.** If there is a specific campsite you would like, please inquire about availability and attendants will do their best to accommodate you. If you see another site you would prefer, return to the gatehouse to check availability, as we may have already assigned it. Every camper is allowed one site change after registration. After the first site change, any additional site changes, except for upgrades, could be subject to a \$5 fee per site, per change. We will gladly change your site if the site is available.
3. Do not change sites without checking with gatehouse staff first. If checked in on a reservation site, check with gatehouse staff for availability to extend stay.
4. Visitation for registered campers is between 7 a.m. and 11 p.m. A \$5 visitor fee per vehicle is charged. (After 11 p.m., a full camping fee is charged.)
5. All camping units and equipment must be placed on prepared gravel sites. Refer to "Campsite Capacity" for regulations. **PLEASE KEEP OFF GRASS.**
6. Quiet hours are observed between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m. Please return to your site during quiet hours as a courtesy to others. To help with electrical cost, please limit the use of extra lights/appliances on your site.
7. Generator use is not permitted during quiet hours.
8. Metal detectors are prohibited in LBL.
9. Check-out time is 3:30 p.m. **A \$16 fee will be added for late departures.**
10. Camping is limited to 21 consecutive days on any site with the exception of our Seasonal Camping Program. After 21 days, the camping unit and person(s) must be moved from the site for a minimum of 7 days prior to returning to the previously occupied site. (36 CFR 261.58(a))
11. To properly occupy a site, all camping units must be set up on the gravel pad.
12. Displaying sale signs, attempting to sell goods or services, advertising of such services, or distributing

written material without a Forest Service permit is prohibited.

CAMPSITE CAPACITY...

Each paid campsite allows for two vehicles. Additional vehicles and visitors will be charged. Each campsite is limited to a maximum of eight people per site, five overnight vehicles, and two camping units, **only one of which may be wheeled.** When the number of persons wishing to occupy a site exceeds eight, a second site must be rented and occupied. Camping units are defined as follows: **wheeled camping units** (RV, pop-up, trailer, fifth wheel, truck camper, truck with topper) or **tent.** Tarps, awnings, dining canopies, screen tents, or vehicles other than those listed, may not solely occupy a campsite.

EXAMPLES PERMITTED:

- A. Wheeled camping unit and one tent;
- B. Two tents.

EXAMPLES NOT PERMITTED:

- A. RV and trailer (two wheeled camping units);
- B. Fifth-wheel and pop-up.

All vehicles including cars, trucks, vans, and boat, jet ski, or utility trailers must park on the graveled area. Overflow parking is available at all shower buildings and parking lots. Do not park along roads or on grass. **Vehicles may not park on unoccupied sites.** Citations will be written and/or vehicles towed at owner's expense.

National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Access, Senior Passes, Golden Age, and Access Passes honored for **50% off basic camping fees, \$6 nightly discount.** Please see gatehouse staff for refund policy. Water will not be available at sites in March and November.

CAMPING SHELTERS (CABINS). . .

Camping Shelters are ideal for people who want a more comfortable camping experience. One-room shelters sleep four and include: one double bed, one bunk bed, ceiling fan with light, small table and chairs and electrical outlets.

OTHER SERVICES. . .

Ice and firewood are available for purchase at the Outpost and Gatehouse. Soft drink machines are located at some shower buildings. Washers and dryers are available at B, C, and D shower buildings.

RESERVATIONS...

Reservations are available for camping shelters and campsites at Piney and Wranglers Campgrounds. Reservations are also available for select campsites at Hillman Ferry and Energy Lake Campgrounds.

1. Reservations for Piney Campground may be made via our website at www.lbl.org or by phone at 1-800-525-7077.
2. Reservations may be made up to six months in advance and no less than two days before arrival.
3. Non-refundable reservation fees shall be charged (see Our Fees).
4. Change fees apply when a customer requests a change to existing reservations (see Our Fees).
5. Customers will receive a full refund less the non-refundable Reservation fee for cancellations more than three days before scheduled arrival.
6. Customers shall be charged the non-refundable Reservation fee, the Late Cancellation fee and the first night's camping fee for cancellations three days or less before scheduled arrival.
7. Check-in time for reserved sites is 4:30 p.m. Check-out time is 3:30 p.m. A \$16 fee will be added for late departures.

SEASONAL CAMPING...

A limited number of campsites are available for seasonal camping for two to nine months. For information, call LBL at 270-924-2044.

FOR YOUR SAFETY...

1. **Pets MUST be on a leash of 6 ft. or less and under physical control at all times.** No farm animals.
2. For health and sanitation purposes, you are required to clean up after your pet.
3. Campers under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
4. Immediately report any theft, loss, accident, or disturbance to the staff or call 911.
5. Fireworks are prohibited at all times.
6. Firearms are prohibited except during LBL hunting seasons by licensed and permitted hunters.
7. Archery target practice is permitted only in designated areas. Broadhead arrows are prohibited.
8. All campfires must be contained in designated fire rings. **Please extinguish all campfires thoroughly before vacating your site. Do not leave unattended. (36 CFR 261.5(d))**
9. The designated beach and swimming area is open during daylight hours; availability is dependent on lake conditions.
10. Pets, alcoholic beverages, and glass containers are not permitted on the beach, in swimming areas, or in bathrooms or showers.

11. **Alcohol consumption is only permitted on your campsite. Please be discreet with your consumption of alcohol on sites.**

RULES OF THE ROAD...

1. A 15 mph speed limit is enforced throughout the campground. Please be courteous and cautious, driving slower in congested areas.
2. Golf carts may serve as an additional means of transportation for individuals displaying an **official state-issued accessible window tag or license plate.** Only the individual issued the tag is permitted to operate the golf cart unless a physical impairment does not allow.
3. Motorcycles must be properly licensed and used on camp roads only.
4. **All motorized vehicle operators must be of legal age and possess a valid permit/drivers license. No double riding is allowed and safety helmets are required. No Power Wheels on campground roads at anytime. All federal and state laws apply.**
5. All-terrain vehicles (ATVs & UTVs) are prohibited. They may not be unloaded in camping areas. Please visit Turkey Bay Off-Highway Vehicle (OHV) Area for off-road riding.
6. **Please observe "No Wake Zones" near swimming areas, boat ramps, courtesy docks, and fishing pier.**
7. After quiet hours, please limit vehicle traffic to entering and/or exiting campground.

OUR ENVIRONMENT NEEDS YOUR HELP...

LBL is working toward a cleaner, healthier environment.

1. **Discharge of gray and black water is prohibited by law. Please use dump stations. Citations will be written.**
2. Vehicle maintenance is prohibited within the campground.
3. **When cleaning fish and other game, please dispose by double bagging and putting in boat ramp dumpsters. Do not use bathrooms, sinks, or water faucet/hydrants for cleaning.**
4. Do not wash dishes, brush teeth, or wash up at potable water sources.
5. For your safety, drinking water is treated and monitored by employees with state certifications.
6. **To protect water supply from harmful bacteria, please do not leave water hoses attached to water hydrants when not in use. Hoses must be removed from hydrant areas.**
7. Waste water is processed on-site through state permitted treatment facilities. Please help us maintain the quality of treatment by using biodegradable detergents and antifreeze. Remember, ultimately, the treated water is discharged into the lake.
8. This campground recycles. Recycling bins are available for your use throughout the campground.
9. **Do not nail, carve, or hang lanterns on trees. It will damage and destroy our natural resources.**
10. **Wildlife and plants are protected.** Please do not feed the wildlife.
